WHAT CAN YOU DO?

PRE-PLANNING

Transportation

- 1. Take the Burner Bus
- 2. If you drive, make sure the tires on your car/RV are properly inflated
- 3. If you are flying, take flights without layovers
- 4. Rideshare/stuff share
- 5. Ship stuff in container if you can (instead of flying with it)
- 6. Rent storage in Reno, NV (if you're planning to come back)

Waste

- 1. Bring less stuff than you think you need (esp. if it's your first time)
- 2. Buy outfits from thrift stores (instead of new items)
- 3. Remove packaging from things you bring to the playa
- 4. Buy drinks in aluminum cans (not plastic or glass)
- 5. Avoid plastics or MOOPy outfits
- 6. Wash & reuse your burn stuff after playa

Food/Water

- 1. Bring less food than you think
- 2. Shop locally
- 3. Reduce or avoid meat consumption
- 4. Bring your reusable water bottle
- 5. Fill up reusable jugs with tap water instead of single use bottle

Energy

- Energy efficient cooling
- 2. Rechargeable batteries

ON THE PLAYA

- 1. Turn off your lights, cooling/fans and other devices when not in use
- 2. Conserve water
- 3. Sort your waste properly recycle & compost
- 4. De-moop regularly
- Share ice
- Share your ideas!

Reduce Waste

- 1. Remove packaging from things you bring to the playa.
 - For example, if you buy granola bars, remove the cardboard box before you come. Remove cellophane type plastic, small wire ties, stickers that come on vegetables and fruits before you get to the playa!
- Avoid using plastic bags for fruits and veggies at the grocery store.
 It's just going to be more waste to take home. Put your food in reusable bags. Planahead.
- 3. Buy drinks in aluminum cans (not plastic or glass).
 - Aluminum cans are the only thing that can be recycled into the same quality. They smoosh down easily once used and are lighter than glass (saves on weight for transportation and, therefore gas usage), plus aluminum can be recycled on the Playa! Plastics are around for >400 years, and the heat can cause harmful chemicals to leak into your beverages and then get into your body.
- 4. Buy outfits from thrift stores (instead of new items).

 It's more fun to score unique things from thrift stores. Support local businesses that are
- good for the community and help extend useful life for these things.
- 5. Know before you go! Learn more about your camp's and pods waste management – recycling, composting, etc. Take the time to sort your waste, think about where you will dispose of it after playa.
- Avoid plastics! Please no more glowsticks and other unnecessary wasteful plastic items. Think before you buy. Scientists predict that Plastic production will increase by 40% in


Burn Week Volunteer Shifts Update


